#### FROM THE DESK OF PASTOR JOHN



While community is a buzzword, it remains an elusive experience. We all hunger to belong, but community is not built in meetings and events. Rather, community is nurtured in mutual service and interdependence, in significant interaction and vulnerability, in shared stories and common purpose.

My grandfather used to remind me that you could learn something from anyone, if you are willing to listen and be present. Now, not all lessons are created equal, but I 've learned to never discount the value of what a person brings to the table. There is something the couple who has been married for 60 years can teach you about commitment that you cannot learn in a book. A parent who cares for their sick children will teach you more about unconditional love than a conference. And the list goes on: faithfulness from the member who has been attending the same church for 75 years, perseverance from one who has been battling a chronic illness, or joy from a child painting on a canvas. You can 't experience these in a classroom.

I have been blessed with the opportunity to study with some amazing people, both teachers and students. I 've been a part of some wonderful courses, conferences, and retreats. As a pastor, it is so tempting to equate these experiences with becoming an expert at life. But the truth is, many "experts" have watched churches die in their presence. Experts won 't save the church.

Here is what I believe God is reminding me about life and learning:

\*There comes a time when I need to put the books down and let members of the church teach me, and watch God get to work. I have to show up, not just on Sundays, but the rest of the week as well.

\*Don 't get so caught up in knowledge, career advancements, or being in control, that I forget to be present to those around me, especially my church family. Not only to learn, but to grown, surrender to, and experience this beautiful gift called church community.

\*Don 't overlook people because they don 't fit the mold of success or have authority, or it's inconvenient to my schedule, or I 'm not called to a particular ministry.

There are amazing people who pass by us daily. Don 't miss the lessons they have to share because they don 't have the title, haven 't written a book, or don' t add some preconceived idea of what you think adds value to your life. Build relationships with those around you and let God 's Spirit form and teach you through those interactions. We are all called to surrender and love one another.

In the process, you might be surprised how much you have to give in return.


